

## Peace Valley Students Raise Money for Haiti

In September, Dan Zeigler spoke at a Peace Valley chapel about his work in Haiti. Dan has been to Haiti about 35 times, and he showed slides of many of the projects he is involved with. Dan was in Haiti during the earthquake in January of this year, working with a water purification plant so that the families of Labaleine, Haiti would have clean water to drink. After the earthquake, many of the large water containers from the plant were taken to people in Port-au-Prince who needed clean water desperately.

Dan proposed a project to the elementary students at Peace Valley: help replenish the jugs for the families of Labaleine. The large jugs cost approximately \$5.00 a piece. Mr. Zeigler has trained the Haitian people to run the water purification plant, but they are in need of these containers for each family.

As a school-wide Christmas project, Peace Valley collected money to purchase large water containers for each family in Labaleine, Haiti. We are thrilled that when Dan returns to Haiti in January 2011, he will be able to use the \$735.00 collected to purchase 147 water bottles!
