For the past month fourth grade has been learning about electricity. The focus of the unit has been on electric circuits. The students learned how to build a simple circuit and then how to build more complex circuits. They also learned how Christmas lights work (and why when one light goes out they all go out)!



An exciting activity that was part of the unit was when the fourth graders were able to practice their circuit building skills by making a flashlight! Last week the students finished their unit on electricity by demonstrating all that they learned by wiring their own cardboard house!
