

# SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR PLUMSTEAD CHRISTIAN STUDENTS

- Assignment books will be supplied to all students, grades 6-12.
- Students will need to have 3-ring binders with plenty of lined paper. (In high school, some students prefer a small binder for each class, rather than one large binder. (If any teachers requested a separate or specific sized binder, it will be listed below.)
- Students should also have a good supply of pens, pencils and erasers as they will be used in all subject areas. These supplies will need to be restocked periodically throughout the year.
- It is recommended that your child own a public library card before the start of school. This will aid in accessing library databases set up by the State of PA.
- Check the PCS website for **Summer Reading List** for books, reading, and project(s) required.
- It is preferred that students do not use wheelie backpacks. They do not fit in their lockers. There is a minimal storage space in the classroom
- From the office: It would be appreciated if each student would donate one or two packs of white copy paper to the school office to cut down on the copying costs. This is *not* a requirement.

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## MATH

**For Math Classes that require a graphing calculator**

A graphing calculator (TI – 83+ or TI-84, ) is the recommended model is required for all math courses, Algebra II and above. It is to the students’ advantage to know how to perform all of the basic functions (including square, square roots, and higher exponents) prior to the beginning of Algebra II.

For all other math classes (Geometry and below) a calculator that has  $X^2$ , square root, higher exponent (^) buttons, as well as memory and trigonometric functions is all that is needed. (TI – 30 series are sold at Wal-Mart for roughly \$10 – \$15)

TI-82, TI-83, TI-83+, and TI-84 models are also acceptable.
