December 1-4, 2011

(After you receive your assignment, a small position paper will be required to attend)

High School Students Only

PMUNC is a dynamic, exciting conference designed to engage students in international and political affairs through cooperation and creativity. Students will be required to participate on a committee and be involved in debates. There will be about 1000 delegates from all over the world.

Registration: Due no later than August 15. Registration money is due with the registration.

Lodging: Princeton Hilton Conference Center and Hotel for two nights
Reservations are very limited so all registrations need to be in by the due date.

Cost: \$450 which includes registration, hotel, meals and transportation to and from the school. (This is based on four people per hotel room.)
