

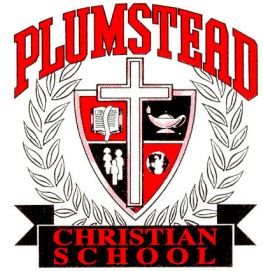

Dear Sixth – Tenth Grade Parents and Students,

Commitment to service in our community is a major goal of PCS and is a crucial element in the Christian walk. Built into our calendar are two service days (March 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>) in which both the Junior High and Senior High do service projects for our community. This year, however, we have decided that those two days are going to be used as make-up days for lost time in the classroom due to the recent snow storms.

In lieu of the two days of service at the school we have decided that it would be an enriching experience for the students to give back to their own churches and communities through volunteer service work (This will not include service in their own home or for a family member). In order to fulfill this obligation they will commit to 8 hours of volunteer service in their communities (broadly speaking). The hours would need to be fulfilled by April 30<sup>th</sup>. (If the hours are not accomplished by April 30<sup>th</sup> the students may work at the school fair on Saturday, May 1<sup>st</sup>) The students will need to fill out a form demonstrating their completion of the hours with the signature of a supervisor or parent. This form must be passed in to their Bible teachers, eventually reaching Mr. Armandt. This will be a wonderful opportunity for students to go out and explore different ways that God may be calling them to be a Christ like example. However, if the students are already serving in various voluntary roles they are permitted to use their service in these roles to fulfill their obligations. (Ex: church nursery, soup kitchen and etc.)

In the students' Bible class they will be given clarification as to what criteria will be accepted for service in the community. Mr. Armandt will also be holding school-wide service projects on two Saturdays (April 3<sup>rd</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>) for those unable to find service options on their own.
