Students at the elementary campus of Plumstead Christian School recently participated in a “Soup-er Bowl” activity to benefit the local community. The children were challenged to bring in as many cans of soup as possible for a one week period. The class that collected the highest average number of cans per student would win a special dress-down day, and the donated cans of soup would be delivered to the Open Hand Ministry of Calvary Church in Souderton, which works with local food banks and community organizations to collect food, coats and hats, and school supplies.
